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Job Opening: Licensed Mental Health Clinician at Developmental FX

DFX is growing – are you a Licensed Mental Health Clinician with experience in pediatric care looking to make a transformative impact on young lives? Consider joining our multidisciplinary team!

DFX works to transform the lives of children who have neurodevelopmental disabilities and mental health challenges so that they can live to their fullest potential. Established in 2003, we have expanded our reach beyond our Denver clinic by sharing our model of care locally, nationally, and globally through mentoring, research, and training, under the direction of co-founder Tracy Stackhouse, OTR/L, a leading pediatric occupational therapist.

As part of the DFX team, you will provide direct mental health clinical treatment for children who have mental health and developmental challenges, and supportive services and treatment for families (parents, siblings, and family systems) through offering resources and wraparound care that will enable each child and family to find a clear path forward. This part-time position (20 hours per week) that has the potential to grow into a full-time role if that is a fit for the clinician hired into the role. The ideal candidate will have 3 or more years of experience in pediatric practice including a neurodiverse population.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide mental health problem identification, and individual, group, and/or family therapy to assigned clients
- Provide case management services to clients as needed or assigned
- Develop treatment plans; monitor treatment progress and follow-up
- Provide consultation, training services, and parent navigation support as part of programs & community partnerships
- Using care mapping, coordinate client's use of other resources
- Participate in team/department meetings, in-services, and supervisory sessions

REQUIREMENTS:

- Master's Degree in counseling, social work, or Ph.D. or PsyD in psychology
- Current CO license (LPC, LPCC, LCSW, MFT, or clinical psychologist)
- Three years' experience in mental health and/or educational setting
- Bilingual Spanish/English skills
- Pediatric experience

SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES:

- Knowledge of methods of psychotherapy including early childhood mental health and development
- Experience with interpersonal neurobiological and family systems approaches
- Ability to assess crisis situations and intervene appropriately
- Knowledge and understanding of trauma-informed and trauma-responsive care principles/practices
